Frequently Asked Questions (that parents may ask)



Q. What should I make sure is packed for camp?

A. Here is a list of things to bring (please mark these items with a name so they may be returned if lost) **Camp Homelani is not responsible for lost or stolen items:**

Q. What things should not be taken to camp?

A. The following items are **not allowed** at camp:

If these items are brought to camp, they will be confiscated and held by the Camp Director until the end of camp. Camp Homelani assumes no responsibility for any of these items.

Q. Will there be a snack bar?

A. Yes, canteen (snack bar) will be available on a scheduled basis and campers will be limited on the number of items they can purchase per day. Campers with \$10 will have enough to provide for their snacks every day. Money should be given to chaperones or individual counselors at the start of camp. All unused money will be returned to the camper on the last day of camp.

Q. Can I call my child?

A. Because of the camp activities, please refrain from calling during the camp session. The camp staff will call you if necessary. In the event of an emergency, the camp business number is 637-4131.



Q. Can I visit my child?

A. Due to limited facilities, we discourage family and friends from visiting the camp. If you would like to visit, please **call in advance** so we may schedule your visit.
